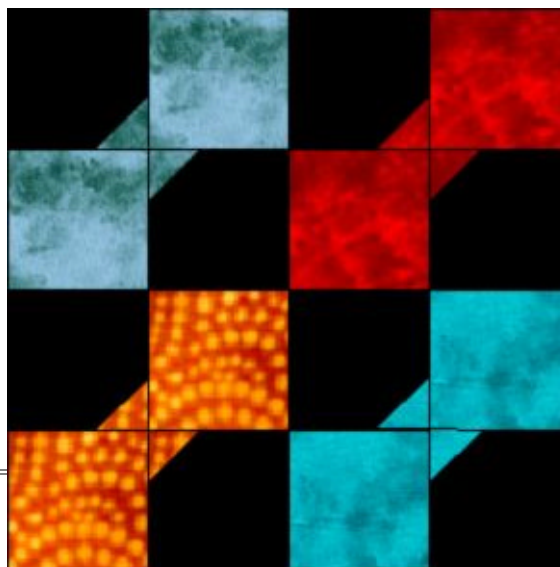

Fabric required:

Brights - Scraps

Black - 1/4 yard



Supplies:

Black color cotton thread

Template plastic for templates

Scissors

Basic sewing supplies

Cutting the patches required:

Two methods given:

Templates: Transfer the patterns to template plastic and use to cut fabric patches required.

Foundation Piecing: Cut fabric 1/2" to 3/4" larger than the patch.

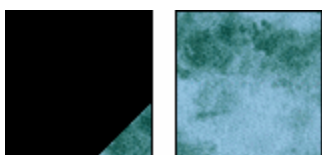

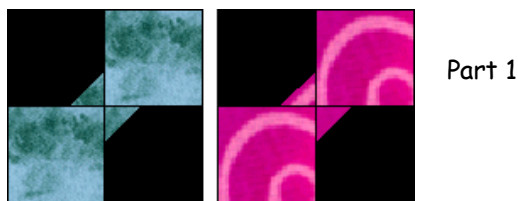

Piecing Instructions for the Bowtie Block

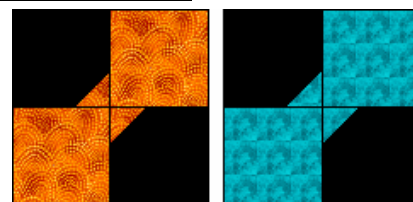
1. UNIT 1: With right sides together sew a dark background piece to a light triangle, using a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowance, to make the unit as shown below.
2. Then sew the light square to the pieced section make 1/2 bowtie.
3. Create 2 such units per color, 8 units in total. Press seam allowances toward the dark.



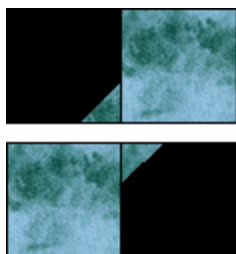
5. UNIT 3: Position and sew two bowtie units as shown below, matching the center seam. Press the seam allowance in opposite directions. Make 2 units per block.



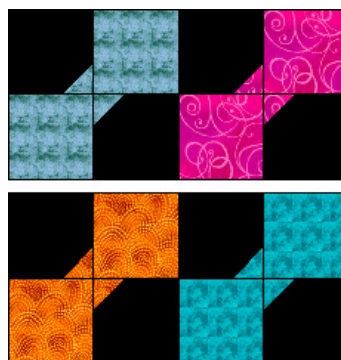

4. UNIT 2: Sew same color bowtie units together to make a complete bowtie block as shown below. Sew 4 bowtie units per block.



8. Unit 4: Sew units 2 together as shown below, right sides facing and matching the center seam. Press the seam allowance to one side.

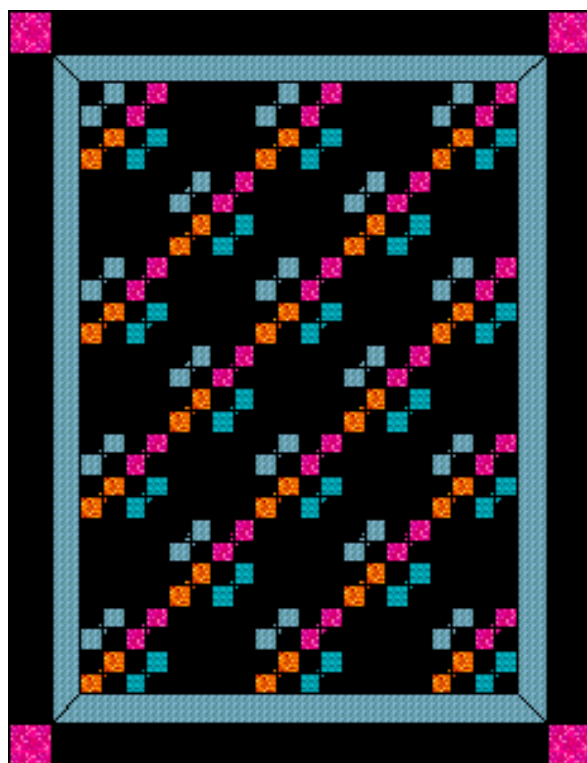

2nd Border: 6" wide



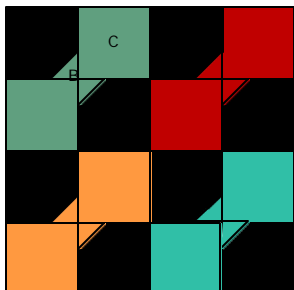
