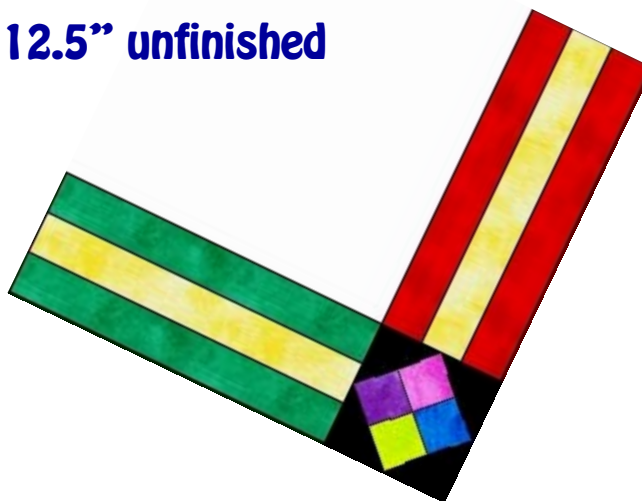
Sash Strips and Cornerstone block

Block Size:

4.5" Finished, 5.0" Unfinished

Sash strips size

4.5 x 12" Finished, 5" x 12.5" unfinished

Sash Strips and Cornerstone block

Fabric required:

Brights - 17 bright colors sizes larger than 13"x 5"

Plus same color scraps for the cornerstone block

Black - 1/8 yard



Supplies:

Black color cotton thread

Template plastic for templates

Scissors and/or rotary cutter

Basic sewing supplies

Cutting the patches required:

Templates: Transfer the patterns to template plastic and use to cut fabric patches required.

Foundation Piecing: not applicable



Instructions for Sash and Cornerstone Block

Cutting:

Cornerstone B template :

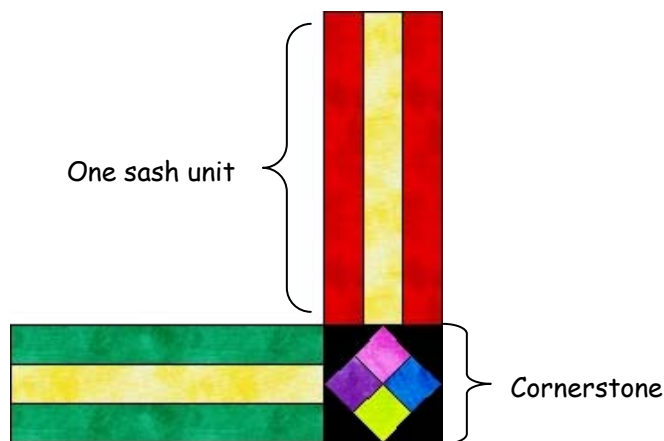
Cut 24 squares using scraps that match value of the colors already in your quilt. They don't have to be the same fabric just the same value.

Cornerstone C: Template:

Cut 24 black or background triangles.

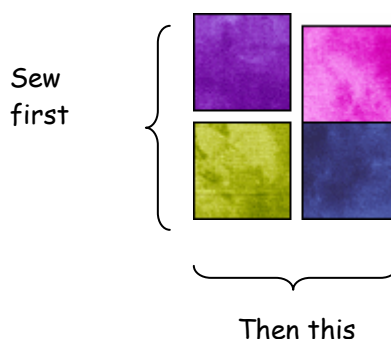
Sash Strips:

Cut 17 light value center strips 2.0" X 12.5"
Cut 34 outer edge strips / at least two per color.
2.0" X 12.5" Use darker value than the center strip.
(see the image below)

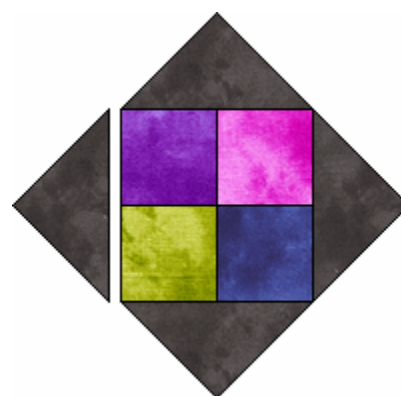


Cornerstone:

Using the square fabrics cut from the B template, Sew 17 - 4 patch units together to create the inner portion of the cornerstone patch.



Then sew one black triangle to each of the four sides.



Sash Unit:

Sew one center strip to the lengthwise edge of the long edge strip to make 17 sash units. Press toward the dark side.

Then sew the second outer edge strip to the other side of the center strip. Press toward the dark side.
